→ Who can join the Brigade?

- Anyone interested in volunteering abroad, learning about different cultures and making new friends!
- The Che Brigade is centered in Canada but is open to people living in or outside Canada. People of all nationalities are welcome to join! All activities will have English translation.

→ What kind of work will we do?

It depends on the specific needs when we arrive in our host communities, and is often agricultural or light construction work. Everyone is encouraged to participate but different kinds of work are possible based on our individual physical conditions.

→ How much does it cost?

The cost of the 2022 Che Guevara Brigade is \$1080 Canadian. This includes your accommodation, all meals, travel and activities within Cuba. It does not include your flight and medical/travel insurance, which can be purchased independently or through our travel agent.
